Control access. On your terms.

A lightweight agent connects each computer to TrustFlare. Your policy decides whether it can sign in.

01

Install

A desktop agent for macOS, Windows or Linux.

02

Approve

An administrator approves the device. Phone approval where policy allows.

03

Sign in

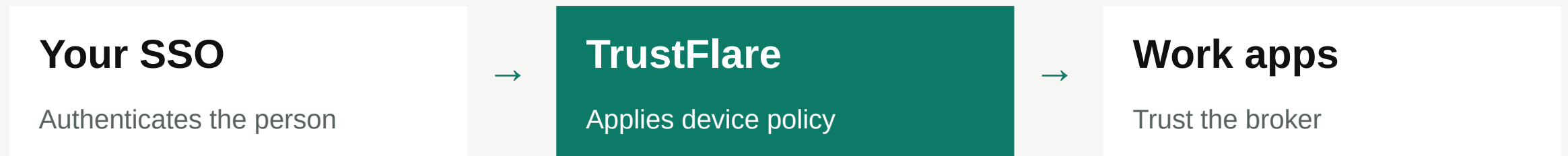
TrustFlare checks device approval before protected access.

Company-owned or personal. No mandatory MDM rollout or browser extension.

TRUSTFLARE SSO BROKER

Keep your cloud SSO. Add a device-trust layer.

TrustFlare connects to your SSO as an application — and acts as the sign-in broker for connected work apps.



Your SSO handles primary authentication and MFA. TrustFlare adds the device check; apps connect through the broker. VPN integration is scoped per pilot.

LESS FRICTION. A CLEAR ACCESS BOUNDARY.

Approved laptop. Fewer sign-in steps.

Eligible, approved devices can sign in without a password when your policy enables it.

Approve new devices. Revoke lost ones. See why a sign-in was allowed or denied.
